Incident Summary: On October 3, 2021 at approximately 4:47 p.m. officers were dispatched to the area of E. 18th Avenue and Louis Avenue on an unknown complaint. Upon arrival the officers located the victim of a stabbing, identified as DENNIS FUQUA and witnesses. According to witnesses, Mr. Fuqua arrived at 1725 Louis Avenue when he was confronted by RICOLE L. CURTIS. The two of them argued and began to fight. During the fight Mr. Fuqua was stabbed multiple times by Mr. Curtis. Mr. Fuqua was transported to an area hospital in critical condition.

This incident is still under investigation.
