## **MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING #2021-09**

## BETWEEN THE CITY OF COLUMBUS AND AFSCME, OHIO COUNCIL 8, LOCAL 2191 "VACCINATION INCENTIVE PAY"

Pursuant to Section 32.2 <u>Changes in Conditions of Employment Which Are Not Specifically Established by Contract</u>, of the collective bargaining agreement ("CBA") between the City of Columbus Board of Health and AFSCME Local 2191, Ohio Council 8, the parties agree to the following terms and conditions:

The City of Columbus and Columbus Public Health recognize the members of the AFSCME Local 2191 bargaining unit who making the choice to protect the health of their co-workers, clients, customers, patients, and the general public from severe illness that may lead to hospitalization and death from exposure to COVID-19 by voluntarily getting fully vaccinated against COVID-19. For this voluntary choice and action, effective with the pay period that includes November 1, 2021, bargaining unit employees meeting the below eligibility criteria will receive a one (1) time payment of five-hundred dollars (\$500) less, withholdings.

## Eligibility Criteria

 All full-time and part-time employees who voluntarily provide to the CPH Human Resources Office, no later than November 1, 2021, proof of receipt of one (1) dose of the Johnson & Johnson/Janssen vaccine or two (2) doses of the Pfizer-BioNTech or Moderna vaccines.
