**Incident Summary:** On Wednesday, October 6, 2021 at approximately 8:11 p.m., Columbus Police Patrol officers were dispatched to the area of South James Road and South Ashburton Road on the report of a shooting. Upon officers arrival, the victim, Tyrese Shute, was found suffering from an aparent gunshot wound. He was transported by CFD Medics to a local area hospital in stable condition for treatment. Mr.Shute stated that as he was walking in the alley with friends, he heard several gunshots. Mr. Shute was then struck in the upper body. Mr. Shute and his friends were able to run from the area and telephone police.
