Applicant: Short North Alliance

Location: The sidewalk area at the northeast corner of N. High Street & Fourth Avenue
Adjacent to the Stonewall Columbus building

Artist: Lisa McLymont

The Stonewall Columbus Mural Project is meant to celebrate the LGBTQIA+ community, as well as Stonewall Columbus on its 40th Anniversary. Caitlyn Dunn Bebe, introduced the project to the Art Commission for input at the July 21, 2021 hearing by Preliminary Project Discussion. The SNA was working with the Department of Public Service (DPS) to determine if the mural could extend from the north wall of the Stonewall building to the sidewalk at the corner of N. High and Fourth. Further, they were working with DPS on use of either a specialized paint or the use of an applied material called Thermoplastic

An artist call was completed and Lisa McLymont was selected as the project artist. It has also been determined that the material used for the sidewalk design will be Thermoplastic. This is to be a temporary project is expected to last approximately five years.

Commission Action Requested: Motion for Final Approval of the design and placement of the temporary artwork, Stonewall Rainbow, on the sidewalk area at the northeast corner of N. High and Fourth Avenue, per CC3115.04(B).
