**Incident Summary:** On November 4, 2021, at 2:03 a.m., officers responded to the 3900 block of Newton Abbey Ct. on the report of gunshots. After officers arrived in the area, they were notified of a walk-in shooting victim at Diley Ridge Hospital. The victim, who drove himself to the hospital, stated that he was shot by an unknown male black in the area Newton Abbey Lane. The victim suffered several gunshot wounds to both his legs. The victim is expected to survive his injuries.
