Incident Summary: With the arrival of cold weather CPD is reminding people not to leave their car running and unattended, as this could invite crime.

The victim parked her car, leaving it running and the wipers on, before entering the CVS. The suspect, wearing a red, white and blue jacket, likely observed this and crossed the street, from the Marathon station. The suspect was captured on video checking the victims' car door. He loitered in the parking lot waiting for the victim to exit. When she exited he approached her, displayed a gun, and demanded money. The suspect grabbed the victim tearing her shirt. The victim relinquished cash, she had in hand, and the suspect fled.

The Columbus Police Robbery Unit is asking the public for help solving this crime. Anyone who may have observed this suspect (red, white, blue jacket) loitering in the area of E. Livingston and Barnette, and may know his name, contact CPD or Central Ohio Crime Stoppers.
