Incident Summary: On Saturday, December 4th, 2021 at 10:39pm, one male shooter was attempting to shoot an intended victim behind an abandoned house next to the intersection Wyton Ct. & Binbrook Rd. The intended victim got behind his car which shielded him from gunfire. The victim got in the car and drove off in a dark colored sedan which likely has bullet holes. CMM & RM were in their residence which was several houses away. Their house was struck by gunfire. One of the stray rounds pierced the exterior of the house and came through the wall near the bed that CMM was laying in. She was struck by debris from the wall and fragments of the projectile which caused an abrasion to her back. She was treated at the hospital for the wound. GP's house, which is next door, was also struck by gunfire, but none of the projectiles made it inside.
