Incident Summary:
*****UPDATE:** The decedent is Andrew Santiago. The investigation into Santiago's death is ongoing. Anyone with information regarding this incident, is asked to call Columbus Police Homicide Unit at (614) 645-4730 or Central Ohio Crime Stoppers at (614) 461-TIPS (8477).***

On Tuesday, January 4, 2022, at 12:37AM, Columbus Police Officers were called to the 2900 block of Indianola Ave. on a report of a shooting. On arrival, officers found the decedent, a 25-year-old male, suffering from an apparent gunshot wound. CFD Medic 13 responded and pronounced the victim deceased at 12:45AM.

After the shooting a male was seen running from the scene. The decedent's name is being withheld pending notification of next of kin.
