Incident Summary: *Update: 1/5/2022, the victims in this incident have been identified and only their initial are being released at this time.*****

On December 30, 2021, at approximately 8:43pm, officers were dispatched to The 500 Block of N Champion Ave on the report of a shooting. Officers arrived at scene and found the victims suffering from a gunshot wounds. CFD Medics 18 and 20 arrived at scene and transported the victims to Grant Medical Center. Despite receiving lifesaving medical treatment Mr. John Doe I succumbed to his injuries and was pronounced deceased at 10:43pm. Mr. John Doe II is listed in critical condition. The names of the victims are being withheld pending identification and notification of next of kin.
