**Incident Summary: UPDATE: On July 24<sup>th</sup>, 2020 at 2:07 p.m. Columbus Police Officers were called to the area of 2600 Audubon Rd. on a report of a shooting. On arrival, officers located Devontay Stanton suffering from gunshot wounds and was transported to an area hospital where he was later pronounced deceased. Homicide detectives conducted an investigation and filed charges against Jaylon Walker. On August 15<sup>th</sup>, 2020 Mr. Walker was arrested and later indicted. On December 10<sup>th</sup>, 2022 Mr. Walker was convicted by a jury for the following crimes: Murder, Aggravated Burglary, Kindapping, Felonious Assault, Weapons Under Disability and Robbery. On January 20<sup>th</sup>, 2022 Mr. Walker was sentenced by Franklin County Common Pleas Judge Daniel Hawkins to the term of 41 years to life in prison.**
