



Project Locations



Improvements

- Safety improvements at 7 key crossing locations along Cleveland Avenue
- New activated flashing light systems to alert drivers of pedestrians intending to cross the street
- ADA compliant curb ramps
- Bus stop relocations in coordination with COTA

Maintenance of Traffic

 Pedestrian and vehicular traffic will be maintained throughout construction.

Property Impacts

- There will be some permanent property impacts and others where property will be impacted only during construction activities.
- Impacted property owners will be contacted beginning late Summer 2022
