Incident Summary: On May 13, 2022, at 3:10 a.m., Columbus Police officers responded to the 6700 block of Tussing Rd. on a report of shots fired into a residence. Upon arrival, officers made contact with victim #1, who stated he was just leaving a friends apartment, when the neighbor started arguing with him. Victim #1 stated that the neighbor was intoxicated and had a shotgun. Victim #1 stated that he saw the neighbor with the shotgun and preceded to walk away. Victim #1 said that he started walking backwards to keep an eye on the neighbor and that is when the neighbor fired a single gunshot at him. Victim #1 stated he started running towards his apartment to get away from the neighbor and the neighbor continued to chase him. Victim #1 said that the neighbor fired three more gunshots and struck the victim's residence and another apartment. Victim #1 was grazed in the chest by one of the pellets from the buckshot. Victim #1 refused medical treatment.
