Incident Summary: *UPDATE: May 30, 2022, the victim of this homicide has been identified as Trey L. Glover, next of kin notification has been made.*****

The investigation is on-going. On May 29, 2022, at approximately 3:19am, officers were dispatched to the 700 Block of Gibbard Ave on a shots fired call. Officers arrived at scene and were directed to a porch where a victim #2 was found, suffering from apparent gunshot wounds. Victim #2 was transported by Columbus Fire to a local hospital and is listed in critical condition. Victim #1 was found a few houses away and was pronounced deceased by Columbus Fire Medic #18 at 3:30am. The deceased victim's name is being withheld until next of kin notification is made. Circumstances that lead to the incident are still under investigation.
