### **Columbus Police and FBI Announce Joint Collaboration in Missing Person Case** *New Reward Being Offered in the Disappearance of Devin 'Sacoya' Cooper*

The Columbus Division of Police, along with Central Ohio Crime Stoppers, is partnering with the Federal Bureau of Investigation as part of a joint collaboration to help solve the case of a missing Columbus woman.

Devin Cooper, who also goes by Sacoya, was last seen leaving her residence in north Columbus on August 31, 2021, and never returned home. Investigators found her vehicle on the west side, more than a month after the then 33-year-old was reported missing to police. Detectives from the Missing Person's Unit believe she is the victim of foul play.

In partnership with the FBI, Central Ohio Crime Stoppers is now offering a reward of up to \$10,000 for information leading to her location.

The Columbus Division of Police, Central Ohio Crime Stoppers, and the FBI will hold a joint news conference on **Wednesday, September 7, 2022**, at 3 p.m. to discuss the renewed effort to solve this case. Members of the media interested in attending must arrive by 2:45 p.m. at Columbus Division of Police Headquarters.
