Incident Summary: Officers were dispatched to the 900 block of Atlantic Ave on a report of a shooting. A.F and K.W. were in a vehicle in front of A.F's apartment talking when an unknown suspect approached the vehicle and fired one shot into the drivers door. A.F then fled the area and transported himself to St. Ann's Hospital for treatment. Upon arrival at St Ann's, officers were told by the victims the suspect they saw shoot at them is unknown to the victims. While A.F was being treated by medical staff, it was discovered the victim was not struck by a projectile, but was struck by a piece of plastic shrapnel from the armrest/door panel from inside the victim's vehicle. A.F is expected to fully recover from his injuries. The victims did not wish to prosecute.
