Incident Summary:

On Sunday, September 25, 2022, at 4:32AM, Columbus Police Officers were called to 5500 block of E. Livingston Ave. on a report of a shooting. On arrival, officers found two females suffering from apparent gunshot wounds. The decedent, 30-year-old Shamira Rhodes, was pronounced dead, at scene, at 4:47AM, by Truro Township Medic 162. The second victim is 17-years-old and was transported by CFD Medic 823 to a local hospital in critical condition. A third victim, 42-year-old S.B, who had also suffered a gunshot wound, left the scene. S.B. later arrived at Mount Carmel East hospital by private conveyance and is in stable condition.

A fight broke out during a gathering. During the fight, at least one handgun was produced and shots were fired striking all three victims. Investigators are still attempting to determine what prompted the dispute.
