 - More in the works

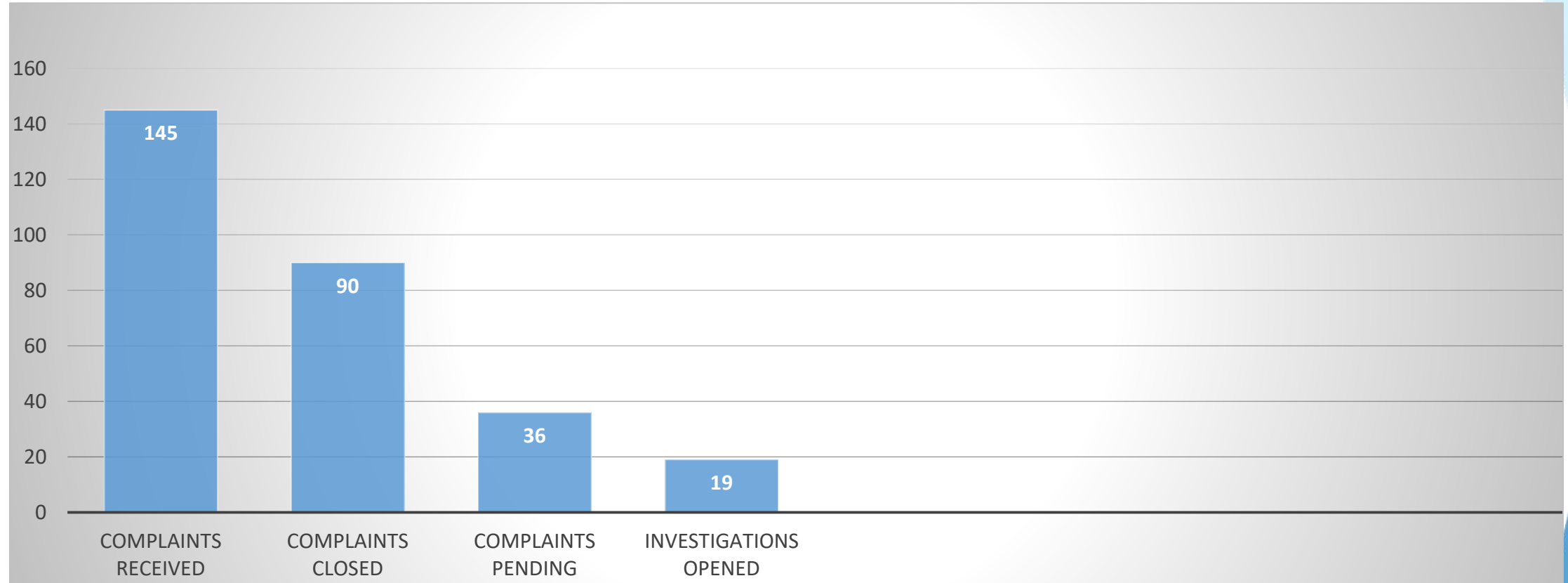

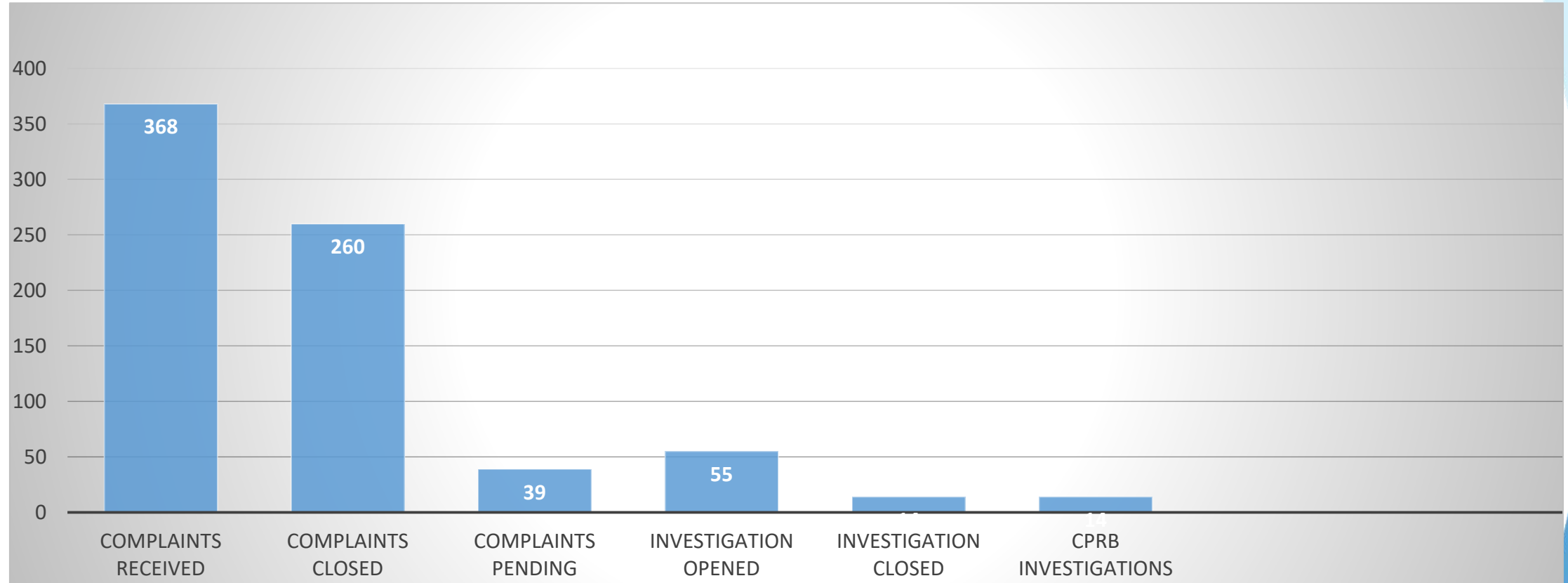
