Incident Summary:

UPDATE: Detectives have filed a Murder charge against 19-year-old Nachyla Halton for causing Chester's death. Halton is currently in custody in the Cuyahoga County Jail on unrelated charges. On Thursday, May 26, 2022 at 11:49PM, Columbus Police Officers were dispatched to the 3600 block of Briggs Rd. to check on the well-being of a resident. On arrival, officers found the decedent, an adult female, suffering from an apparent gunshot wound. CFD Engine 12 responded and pronounced the female deceased at 12:10AM.

The circumstances that lead to this shooting are under investigation. The decedent's name is being withheld pending notification of next of kin.
