Incident Summary: On November 23, 2022, law enforcement was alerted by a citizen that a person was in the pond located at Wilson Road Park. CPD Patrol personnel responded to the scene and did locate the victim Mr. Robert K. Marsh III in the water. CFD personnel pronounced Mr. Marsh deceased at 10:31am. Homicide detectives responded to the scene and an intial investigation revealed that Mr. Marsh was involved in an altercation with the suspect John M. Ferry M/W 46. Mr. Ferry is alleged to have caused injuries to Mr. Marsh that resulted in his death. Mr. Ferry has been charged with Murder and his current whereabouts are unknown. If you see him, do not approach and call police immediately. A photo of the suspect is attached to this release.

This Homicide investigation is ongoing. Anyone with information concerning this investigation is asked to call Columbus Police or Crimestoppers at 614-461-TIPS (8477). This is the 129th Homicide in calendar year 2022. Detective Kelley is the lead investigator and he is being assisted by Detective Huffman.
