

Zone In Columbus Advisory Committee

- Purpose:** To provide input into the strategies and development of a comprehensive zoning code update that is responsive to community needs and furthers equitable opportunity for all Columbus residents.
- Goals:**
- Act as a sounding board for zoning code update team regarding community needs, concerns, and expectations, as well as provide feedback to current and proposed strategies and priorities.
 - Provide input on changes to the Columbus zoning code and identify opportunities to build consensus.
 - Be at the forefront in ensuring transparency and accountability for the update process.
- Responsibilities:**
- Act as an advisor to the zoning code update team.
 - Focus on the group goals and responsibilities over any individual agendas.
 - Be respectful, forthright and honest in sharing insights/perspectives.
 - Disseminate information and materials to respective networks to build community-wide understanding and participation in the process.
- Composition:** Participants have been selected representing diverse backgrounds who have knowledge of community issues, zoning and development, equity disparities, and broader content expertise.
- Meetings:** Advisory Committee will meet monthly for 90 minutes. The general public may observe meetings; all meeting summaries and relevant materials will be posted on the Zone In website after each meeting for public access.
- Leadership:** The zoning code update is a priority initiative for Mayor Andrew J. Ginther that will be implemented by the Departments of Building & Zoning Services and Development in partnership with Columbus City Council.
