Subject: Hatching on Plans

Category: CAD Standards

The purpose of this memo is to define illustration standards for existing and proposed hatching standards.

- 1. Hatches shall be implemented as visual representations of proposed material limits, removals within demolition plans, and for general graphics when accompanied with design details.
- 2. Hatching shall not be used to represent actual sizes of material on plan sheets.
- 3. Hatching shall not be used to represent actual material patterns on plan sheets. Patterns shall be represented on detail sheets.
- 4. Where hatches are applied, a corresponding legend shall be used to identify intent.
- 5. Hatching shall be used sparingly within CIP plans to clarify design intent.
- 6. The designer shall take care not to use hatching that significantly slows the viewing of files in PDF format. Where possible, a standard ANSI hatch pattern should be used.
