Incident Summary: On November 26, 2022 at approximately 10:30 a.m., an unknown suspect entered the Pizza Hut located at 1076 Parsons Ave. The suspect approached the counter and attempted to place an order but did not have enough money to pay for the order stating he just got out of jail and needed something to eat. The suspect was told to hang out for a second while the employee walked to the back of the store. The employee heard a loud bang at the front counter and observed the suspect on the store surveillance monitor unplug wires from the front register taking the cash till. The employee confronted the suspect and told him there was no money in the till. The suspect put his hand in his coat pocket and stated "I have something for you," then fled out the front door. The suspect was observed with the till getting into a black Cadillac in the alley behind an auto parts store next door.					
The suspect was described as a male, black, 30 to 40 years old, 5'8", 180-210 lbs., unshaven, wearing a gray jacket with a fur trimed hood, black hoody, black pants, and white shoes.					
The incident was captured on the stores surveillance cameras and still photos of the suspect are attached.
