Incident Summary: On 02/09/2023, around 12:07 A.M., a single-vehicle motor vehicle crash occurred on I-70 westbound at the exit ramps to I-270 on the east side of Columbus. Initial reports stated that a 2016 Ford Explorer operated by Latosha M. Jordan, 43, of Columbus, was westbound at I-70 approaching the exit ramps to I-270 when the vehicle struck a freeway attenuator causing disabling damage to the vehicle. Ms. Jordan exited the vehicle after the crash, and a passenger, Antonio F. Stubbs, 35, of Columbus, stayed in the vehicle. A witness to the collision, Ronald H. Sipp Jr, 49, of Columbus, entered the freeway from an apartment complex next to the freeway and attempted to assist Ms. Jordan and Mr. Stubbs.

At that time, a 2012 Chevrolet Malibu, operated by Faith Sadler, 20, of Dublin, also traveling westbound on I-70, struck the Ford Explorer, resulting in Ms. Jordan and Mr. Sipp being thrown from the initial crash scene. Ms. Jordan was pronounced dead at the scene of the collision. Mr. Sipp was transported to Mt. Carmel East Hospital with critical injuries. Ms. Sadler was also transported to Mt. Carmel East Hospital with severe but non-life-threatening injuries. Mr. Stubbs was transported to Grant Medical Center with severe but non-life-threatening injuries.

Ms. Jordan's death is the 13th motor vehicle crash fatality in the city limits of Columbus for 2023. The cause of the crash remains under investigation by the Columbus Division of Police Accident Investigation Unit.
