DUE PROCESS HEARINGS

The next item to come before the Board was the Due Process Hearing regarding **Hamilton Remodeling, LLC,** for the property located at **840 Parkwood Avenue. Bryan Hamilton, license holder, was present. Cynthia Burse,** the complainant was present, as well as her attorney,

Ms. Burse's complaint alleged that Hamilton Remodeling had violated Columbus Building Code Sections 4115.01 - Inspections Required, 4115.03 - Approvals Required and 4115.05 - Inspection Before Covering, at the property located at 840 Parkwood Avenue.

Ken Bruen presented the complaint and the information provided by the Inspectors. **Mr. Hamilton** and **Ms. Burse** provided testimony and information for the record.

After discussion and questions by the Board, **Mr. Appeldorn** made a **Finding of Fact** that **Hamilton Remodeling** did fail to acquire the required inspections, failed to acquire the required approvals and failed to obtain approvals before covering. **Mr. Neverman** seconded.

MOTION CARRIED

Based on the *Finding of Fact,* Mr. Appeldorn made a motion to Conclusion of Law that Hamilton Remodeling was *GUILTY* of violating City of Columbus Building Code Sections 4115.01 - Inspections Required, 4115.03 - Approvals Required and 4115.05 - Inspection Before Covering, at the property located at 840 Parkwood Avenue. Mr. Neverman seconded.

MOTION CARRIED

Due to the testimony by **Hamilton Remodeling** and the **City of Columbus**, Hamilton Remodeling was given verbal permission to do the work. **Mr. Appeldorn** made a motion to **TAKE NO ACTION** against their license. **Mr. Neverman** seconded.
