Incident Summary: On 2/19/23 at 9:05pm Columbus Police Officer Hansel Henry was assisting a disabled vehicle on I-670 westbound at the 4th Street ramp. Officer Henry was on duty and using a marked CPD cruiser with the emergency red and blue beacon lights activated. Officer Henry was out of his cruiser and standing on the freeway assisting the motorist when a white Honda Odyssey Minivan operated by Jose Antonio Coria Cadena lost control and struck the marked cruiser. Officer Henry was struck and suffered Serious Physical Harm Injuries from the collision. He was transported to Grant Hospital in stable condition and is expected to survive. No other injuries were reported.

The Accident Investigation Unit responded to the scene and initiated an investigation.

This Serious Injury Crash remains under investigation.
