Incident Summary: On 2/24/23 at around 8:32pm the Clinton Township Fire Chief Vehicle being driven by Clinton Township Fire Chief, Brian Fraley was responding to an emergency call for service. The Clinton Township Fire Chief Vehicle had its emergency lights and siren activated as it was exiting the Clinton Township Fire Station. The emergency vehicle was going north on Cleveland Avenue from the fire station.

At the same time, a 14 year old male pedestrian walked out in the roadway in front of the emergency vehicle. No posted crosswalks were in the area. The Emergency vehicle and pedestrian hit.

The pedestrian was taken to Children's Hospital and sustained Serious Physical Harm Injuries from the crash, he is expected to survive the incident. No other injuries were reported.

The Accident Investigation Unit Responded to the scene and initiated an investigation which is on-going.
