Incident Summary: On Thursday, March 9, 2023, at approximately 3:10 p.m., the Columbus Division of Police executed simultaneous narcotics search warrants in the 600 block of Southwood Avenue and the 3400 block of Southfield Drive East originating from a combination of community and ShotSpotter complaints. The narcotics investigation was conducted by the Zone 5 Community Response Team (CRT5) and the Columbus Police INTAC Unit executed the search warrants. During the search of these residences, officers seized large amounts of narcotics, consisting of fentanyl, cocaine, and marijuana. Additionally, a total of six firearms were confiscated.

The investigation continues and charges are pending.
