



## **Columbus Litter League 2023**

### **League Rules**

1. Columbus Litter League begins on June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2023 and will end on August 31<sup>st</sup>, 2023.
2. Each team must have a captain, a team name, and a roster of no more than 20 players. Any player under the age of 13 must be accompanied by a parent, guardian, or other responsible individual over the age of 18.
3. Teams must select a division in which to complete that best represents the team. The divisions include: Business/Corporations, Nonprofits/Faith-based, Community Groups/Civics, or Individuals/Family. No team may compete in more than one division.
4. Each player or parent/guardian of a minor player must complete a participant liability waiver.
5. Teams will submit their cleanup stats no later than Monday immediately following a cleanup. A photo must be submitted of the collected bags for points to be awarded. The reporting form link will be provided to team captains before the start of the season.
6. Keep Columbus Beautiful will provide each team with equipment that includes safety vests, gloves, litter grabbers, and trash bags.
7. Each team captain must sign an Equipment Loan Agreement.
8. Equipment can be held by the team captain during the Litter League season given that the team is regularly conducting cleanups. After a two week lapse in cleanups, equipment must be returned to Keep Columbus Beautiful at 1265 Marion Rd. during regular business hours.
9. Teams will score 1 point for every full bag of litter collected.
10. When cleaning up, no bulk, illegal dump sites, or homeless encampments will be accepted towards points awarded. All teams will be cautioned against handling these materials. Should a team come across an area as such, they will need to report it by using Columbus 311.
