Incident Summary: On July 2, 2023 at approximately 10:50 p.m., Columbus Police officers responded to the 1600 Block of East Whittier Street on a report of shots fired. Several minutes later, Columbus Police officers also responded to a local area hospital on the report of a walk-in gunshot victim. Upon arrival to the hospital, officers came into contact with the victim, D.S., who was suffering from a gunshot wound to the right arm. It was learned that the victim was inside a residence at the East Whittier Street location when an altercation occurred before shots were fired from outside and struck the residence. One of the shots went through the exterior wall and struck the victim who then left the residence to seek treatment at the hospital. The victim is expected to fully recover from his injury. This incident is still under investigation.
