Incident Summary:

On July 14, 2023, at approximately 8:03 PM, Columbus Police Patrol Officers were called to the 5200 block of Pine Lake Drive on a report of a shooting. Upon arrival officers located the victim, Mr. Tay Green, suffering from apparent gunshot wounds. He was transported to a local hospital by Columbus Fire Medic 6 personnel. Despite life saving efforts, Mr. Green was pronounced deceased at 1:31 AM. Responding Patrol officers were able to apprehend two juvenile suspects, both of whom were charged with the above listed offenses.

This incident appears to stem from a disturbance at an impromptu birthday/pool party by a large group of teenagers who do not live at that location.
