Discharge of Firearm Involving Officer

On Thursday, July 20, 2023, at approximately 5:45 p.m., Columbus Police officers were in the area of West Broad Street and South Ogden Avenue attempting to locate a reported stolen vehicle out of Gahanna. The vehicle stopped at the intersection of Olive Street and South Ogden Avenue, at which time an adult male exited the driver's seat and ran from the vehicle.

Officers ran after the male and located him in a nearby alley. While they were attempting to take the male into custody, one Columbus Police officer discharged their firearm. Officers were able to take the male into custody a short time later. No one was struck by the gunfire. The suspect and an officer were treated at the scene for minor injuries sustained during the foot chase.

The suspect was arrested for a felony warrant out of Franklin County. Additional charges from this incident are pending.

Detectives with the Columbus Division of Police Homicide Bureau are investigating the incident.
