Mr. Miller made a motion to certify the results of the applicants who were approved to the Department of Building & Zoning Services for the issuance of a Demolition Contractor License. Mr. Appeldorn seconded the motion. **MOTION CARRIED**.

The next item to come before the Board was a due process hearing regarding the City of Columbus vs. Doug Maurer for a property located at 1932 Woodcrest Road. Mr. Maurer was charged with violating Columbus Building Sections, 4113.37(B), Building Permits required, 4115.01, Inspections Required, 4115.03, Approvals Required, 4115.05, Inspection Before Covering, and 4114.111, Work of a Licensed Specialty Contractor. Mr. Maurer was present along with his associate, Jim Maurer. Dave Daniel, City of Columbus Structural Inspection Supervisor, stated on October 20, 2014, a Contractor Complaint Form was filed by the owner for a new roof, deck and interior alterations performed without permits. He also stated on that same day, Mr. Maurer pulled deck and roof permits. He further stated Building Inspector, Kathy Temple, performed an inspection at this address on October 23, 2014 and found a new hot water tank, a new furnace, a bathroom installed in the basement, a new sink and new electric in the kitchen, which were all installed without permits. He stated since that time all permits have been obtained by other contractors and they have been approved. Mr. Maurer stated he was only involved in replacing the deck and the roof. He also stated he had the furnace, electric work and kitchen and basement alterations included in his contract, however, he was asked to leave the job before beginning any of that part of the contract. He stated they did remove the tub, but they did not install a new one. He also stated the furnace was on site, but was not hooked up. Mr. Pione made a motion to find that based on the testimony presented, Mr. Maurer failed to acquire building permits as required and failed to obtain required inspections and also failed to engage licensed contractors to perform the work. Mr. Appeldorn seconded the motion. MOTION CARRIED. Mr. Pione made a motion to find Mr. Maurer guilty of violating the abovementioned Code sections. Mr. Appeldorn seconded the motion. MOTION CARRIED. Mr. Miller made a motion to suspend Mr. Maurer's license for a period of 90 days effective immediately. Mr. Appeldorn seconded the motion. MOTION CARRIED.

The next item to come before the Board was the review of a Working Without Permit Affidavit for Bradley Rucker for a property located at 2255 E. Dublin Granville Rd. Mr. Miller made a motion to accept the Affidavit. Mr. Appeldorn seconded the motion. **MOTION CARRIED.**

Mr. Neverman moved to adjourn. Mr. Pione seconded the motion. **MOTION CARRIED.** Adjourned at 3:10 p.m.
