Home Pick Up Makes Yard Waste Recycling Easy!

While you're gardening and landscaping, remember to keep it green and recycle your yard waste in paper (biodegradable) bags or hard sided containers labeled "Yard Waste."

Prepping Yard Waste – 3 Easy Steps

- 1** Place yard waste in biodegradable (paper) bags or rigid containers marked "Yard Waste." Please do not use plastic bags.
- 2** Cut branches to less than four feet long and tie the branches into bundles no wider than two feet with string or twine.
- 3** Watch the weight – no single bag, container or bundle can weigh more than 50 pounds.

Where do I put my Yard Waste for Collection?

Yard waste goes to the street curb. Make sure the bags or containers are at least three feet away from other containers, mailboxes and/or cars.

What is NOT Yard Waste?

- No rocks
- No sod
- No plastic pots
- No concrete or gravel
- No dirt
- No plastic bags
- No food waste

Yard waste is organic waste generated during regular household gardening and landscaping, including:



Grass clippings



Leaves



Twigs



Branches



Shrubby
