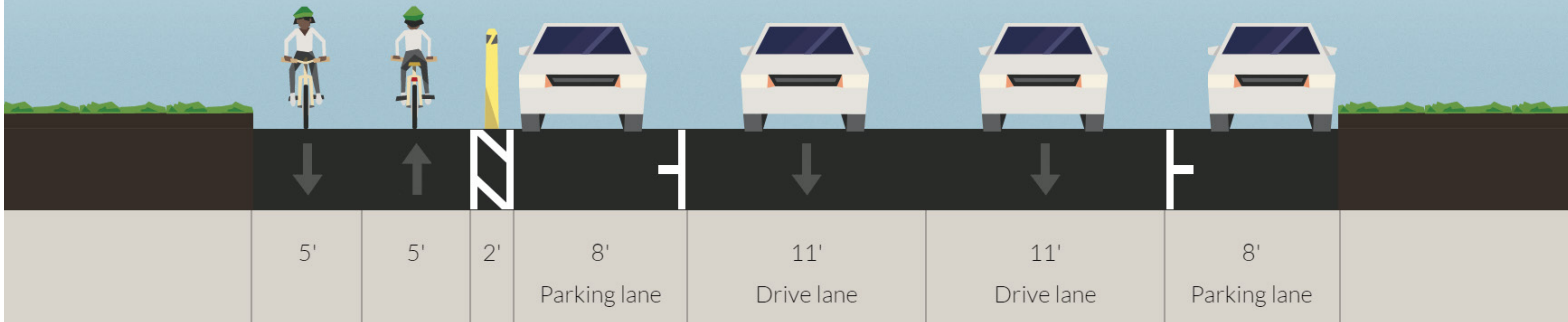


# Summit Street Protected Bike Lane



## What's New?

**PROTECTED BIKE LANES.** Protected bike lanes are physically separated from traffic and the sidewalk (photos right).

**TURN BOXES.** Green turn boxes provide a place that is just for bicyclists to wait when crossing Summit from the protected bike lane (bottom right photo).

**BUS BULBS.** Bus bulbs are concrete islands that separate buses from bikes and provide a safe place for people to wait for buses (photo below).



## If You Are Biking:

- Yield to pedestrians and wheelchair users
- Watch for turning vehicles
- Keep right, pass left
- Use caution when exiting bike lane
- Use green turn boxes



## If You Are Driving:

- Do not park or drive in the protected bike lane
- Look both ways before turning
- Do not block the bike lane or turn box
