The Columbus Recreation and Parks Department is hosting a public open house to present plans to widen the Olentangy Trail, from Antrim Park to Bethel Road. This section of trail receives over 300,000 uses per year, but is too narrow, too close to the river, and includes no access for thousands of people who live in the neighborhoods along the Bethel Road corridor. The open house will show alternatives to connect the trail and Bethel Road, build a shared use path along Bethel Road to Olentangy River Road, and directly connect to a new trailhead at Anheuser Busch Park.

Representatives from Recreation and Parks and Burgess & Niple will be on hand to answer questions and take comments and suggestions. No formal presentation will be given.
