# RELEVANT DATA

- The site is developed as the Beer Stube bar. Surrounding uses include a bar to the south, a carry-out to the north, retail and commercial to the east and residential to the west.
- The applicant requests a variance to reduce the number of additional parking spaces from 5 to 0.
- The applicant proposes to construct a 581 sq.ft. patio for an existing bar.
- 3312.49, Minimum numbers of parking spaces required- eating and drinking establishments without pickup unit- 1:75 sq.ft.
- The site has 4 on site parking spaces. The addition of the 581 sq.ft. patio requires 8 parking spaces, but because the site is in an overlay it is granted a 25% reduction requiring only 5 additional parking spaces.
- The Division of Planning & Operations has reviewed this case and has no issues with the variance requested.

- The University Area Commission has voted to recommend approval of this request pending the following conditions:
  - (1) No outdoor amplification
  - (2) No outdoor electronics
  - (3) No enclosure

#### SUMMARY OF POSITION AND OUTSTANDING ISSUES, IF ANY:

Staff can recommend approval as the site is in a very dense area near the Ohio State University where the majority of patrons will walk and not utilize parking spaces.
