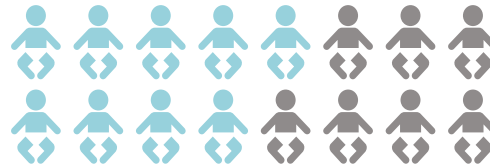

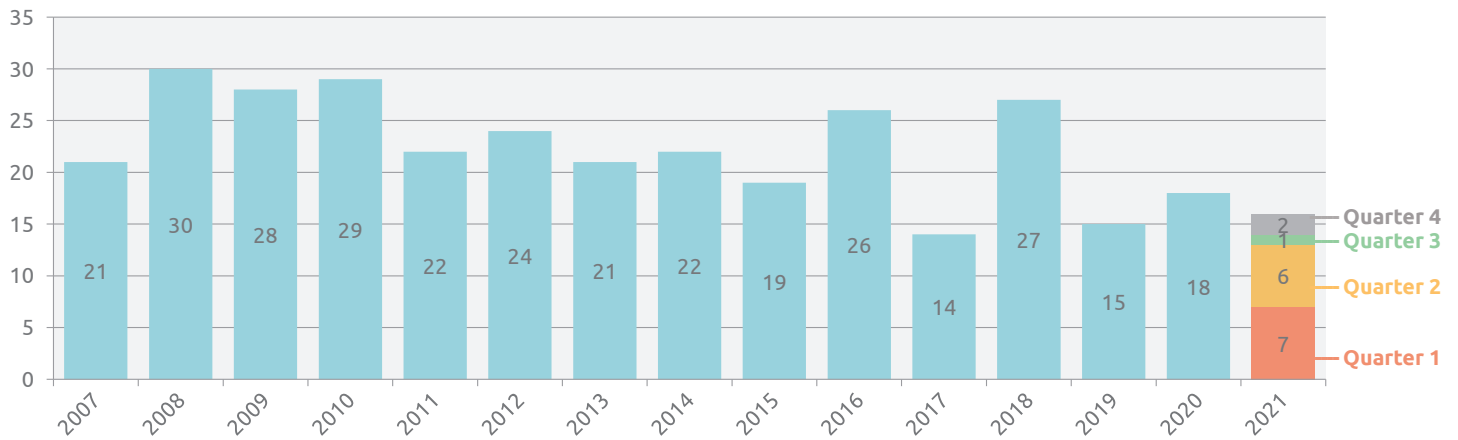

The disparities highlighted on this brief are the result of avoidable and unjust differences in our community driven by systemic racism.

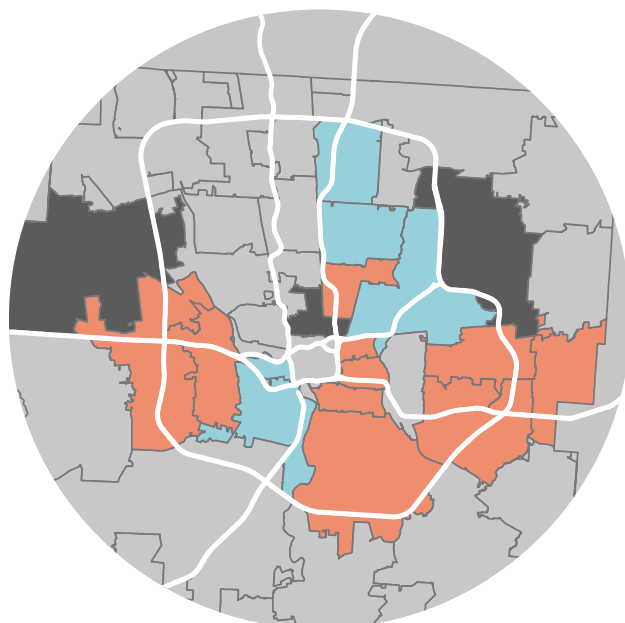

Sleep-Related Infant Deaths by Year (2021 YTD)

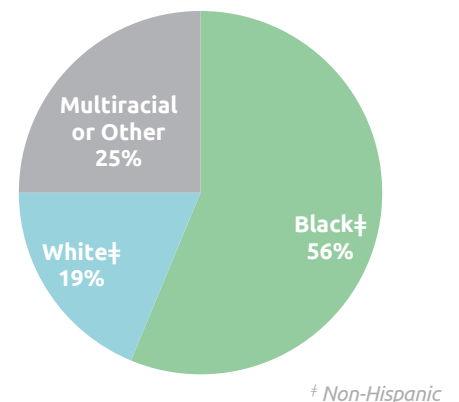

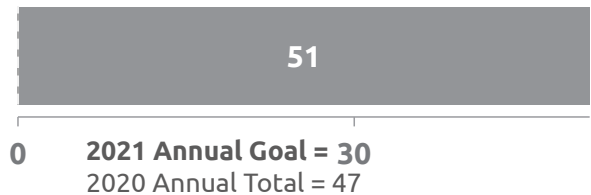

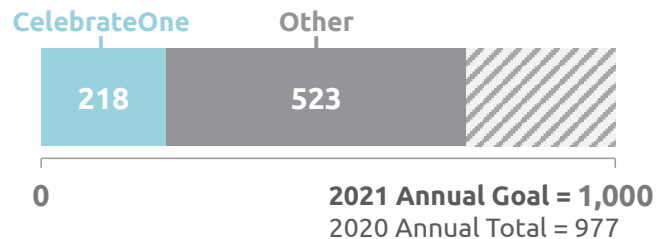
Safe Sleep Training (2021 YTD)

+21 Exceeds Annual Goal

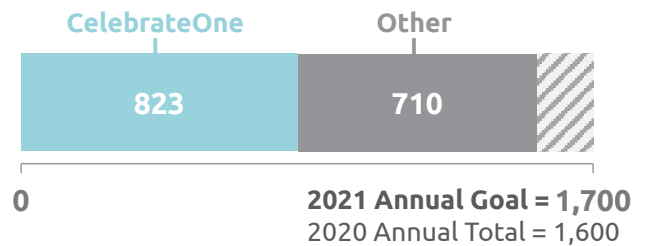


741 Safe Sleep Ambassadors Trained²
