SUMMARY

Councilmember Emmanuel V. Remy and Columbus City Council will soon unveil the **CLEANER COLUMBUS** initiative, a campaign to reduce litter throughout our neighborhoods and city streets. In an effort to engage youth and all residents of our community, Council is asking our local students to design the mascot for the **CLEANER COLUMBUS** campaign.

Students may submit their idea for a mascot online, by mail, or in person at Columbus City Hall by **May 17th**.

MASCOT CRITERIA

The mascot should represent one or more of the following themes:

Pride in My City: I am proud to call Columbus my home, and I want to ensure that my city shines for all to see.

Green and Clean: Cleaning up litter helps to preserve our environment by keeping waste out of our rivers and parks.

The “Litter” of the Law: We respect the laws of our city, and littering is against the rules.

WINNING SUBMISSION

The school attended by the student with the winning submission will receive a **\$1,500** first place prize, awarded in the student's name, to be used in support of arts education or environmental sustainability. Second and third place prizes of **\$500 each** will also be awarded. Columbus City Council will announce the winning submissions on **May 24th, 2019**.
