As Founder and Chief Executive Officer of Eryn PiNK Ltd., Eryn leads an organization of young women who position themselves as role models to girls and teens in Central Ohio. Such work is critically important at a time when girls receive mixed messages -- many of which are negative from the media and their peers -- about what it means to be a girl. Through programs such as Lunch Box Girl Talk School Program, Eryn PiNK Hair Bow Factory and Give That Girl the Mic - all girl talent showcase, Eryn and her merry band of young women mentors emphasize the importance of discovering purpose, modesty, confidence, poise, and the true meaning of beauty for girls.
