How to Participate in a Meeting - Any member of the public wishing to address a commission, board, or panel should submit a speaker slip to staff and attend the meeting in-person. Speaker slips may be submitted via email or in-person before the meeting begins. Anyone who would like to provide comments, but is unable to attend a meeting, may provide written comments by 4:00 PM EST the day prior to a scheduled meeting.

How to View a Meeting* - Meetings will be streamed on YouTube: <http://www.youtube.com/cityofcolumbus>. Streaming will begin shortly after the meeting is convened. Comments received via YouTube will not be part of the official public record for the meeting.

Business Meetings & Panel meetings will not be available on YouTube. Please contact staff with any questions on how to attend a business or panel meeting.
