**Re:** Window Wells

**Requirements:** Section 310.2 of the Residential Code of Ohio provides the minimum requirements for the installation of a window well for emergency escape and rescue. Section 310.4 permits the well to be covered if the cover can be removed from the inside without the use of a key, tool or force greater than that which is required for normal operation of the escape and rescue opening. The code does not indicate when a cover is required over the well except that section 312.1 requires guards to be provided near the open sides of elevated walking surfaces that minimize the possibility of a fall from the walking surface to the lower level.

**Memorandum:** To minimize a fall into window wells, all wells must have a cover meeting section 312.1 unless the well is protected by landscaping located a minimum of 36 inches away from the nearest open side of the well.
