

SUBMITTAL FOR MAXIMUM CAPACITY CARD

FLOOR PLAN OF EACH FLOOR MUST BE DRAWN TO SCALE. 1/8"=1.0" OR 1/4"=1.0"

Floor plan to show in detail and to scale:

- Exterior walls of building or demising walls of tenant space
- All interior walls or partitions
- Doors and direction of swing
- Toilet room fixtures (water closet, urinals, and lavatories)
- Tables and chairs, if applicable
- Booths [one (1) per 24" length] if applicable
- Equipment and fixtures (kitchen equipment not necessary)
- Location of exit signs
- Location of emergency lighting
- Panic hardware, if applicable
- Name and address to be placed on plans
- Aisle widths
- Use of space
 - Meeting room with tables and chairs, or chairs only
 - Classroom
 - Dining room
 - Recreation area (pools, gyms, play areas)

1004.7 Fixed seating

For areas having fixed seats and aisles, the occupant load shall be determined by the number of fixed seats installed herein.

For areas having fixed seating without dividing arms, the occupant load shall not be less than the number of seats based on one person for each 18 inches (457 mm) of seating length.

The occupant load of seating booths shall be based on one person for each 24 inches (610 mm) of booth seat length measured at the backrest of the seating booth.
