



PROJECT TAILLIGHT

MAKING COLUMBUS SAFER ONE VEHICLE AT A TIME

Under the City of Columbus' Project Taillight pilot program, the offer to repair vehicle safety lights is time-sensitive and of limited availability, subject to existing resources, and may terminate at any time. All persons who register and meet the eligibility criteria shall be considered for approval. Only one vehicle per person is eligible. The scope of work includes repair and/or replacement of any vehicle safety light determined to be non-functional by the third-party vendor. While additional services included with the program are provided at no cost, the vehicle owner is responsible any out-of-pocket costs beyond the scope of the third-party contract. The City is not responsible for any error in communication with the third-party vendor, nor liable for any third-party damages, costs beyond scope of performance, or claims. The third-party vendor is responsible for any warranties for services and goods provided. Any documentation provided between the vehicle owner, the City, and the third-party vendor may be subject to public records laws. The City retains authority and discretion to modify these terms at any time.
