

VIDEO 3: How Tax Credits Work Between Cities

What if you live in Columbus but work in another city? While not all cities allow full credit up to their tax rates...

Good news — Columbus gives you credit for the tax you pay there, up to 2.5%.

Let's take some Examples:

If you work in Dublin, where the tax rate is 2%, Columbus gives you credit for that 2%. You'd only need to pay the remaining 0.5% to Columbus.

If you work in Worthington, where the tax rate is also 2.5%, you'll get credit for the full amount — meaning you won't owe anything extra to Columbus.

In short, you'll never pay more than 2.5% total to Columbus for municipal income tax.
