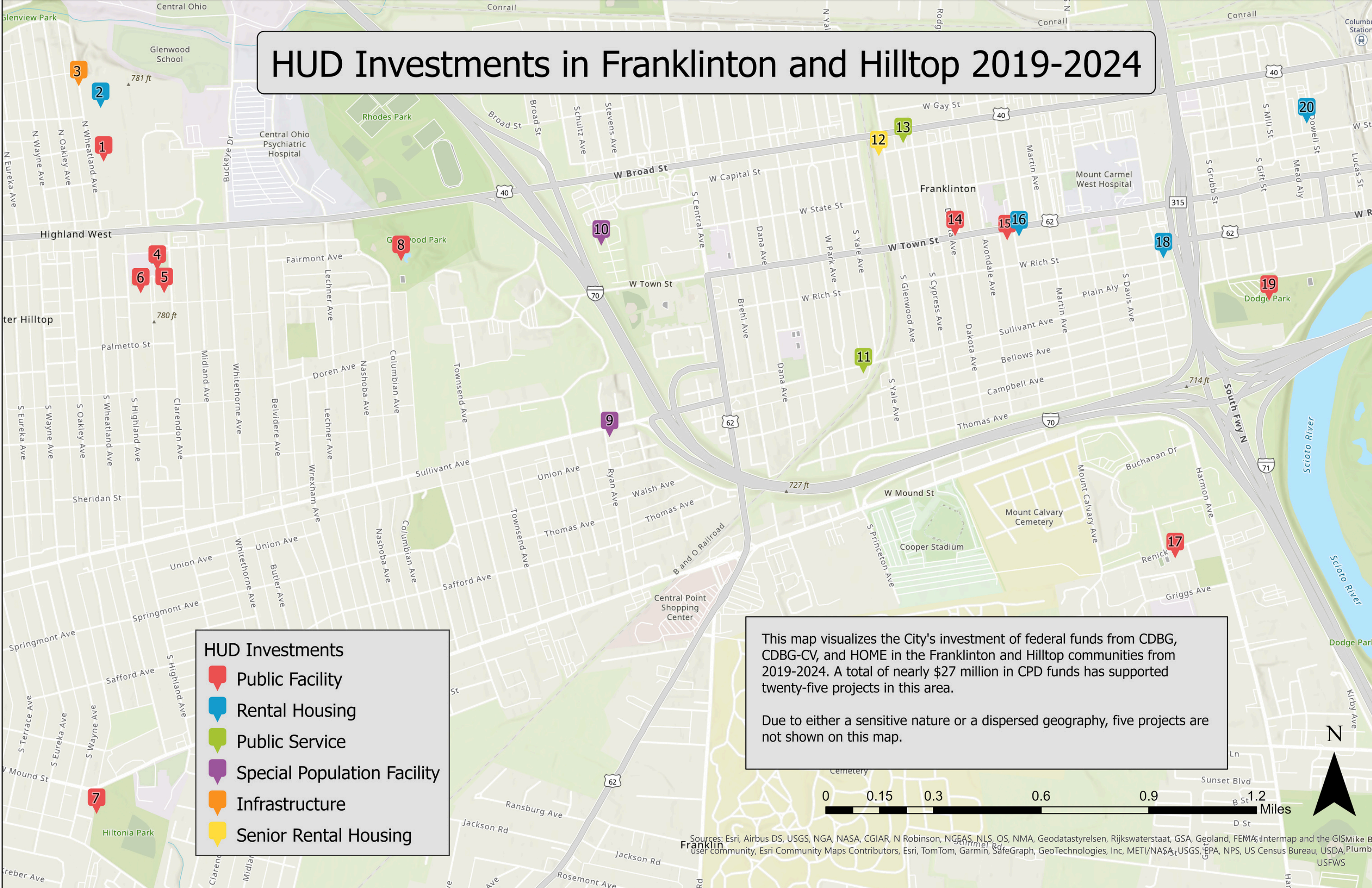

Mid-Ohio Farm on the Hilltop

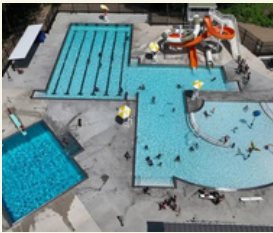
The Mid-Ohio Farm on the Hilltop is an urban "smart farm" that will serve as a research, farming, and educational outreach center for the community. The property is owned by the City's Land Bank, and was developed using CDBG, CDBG-CV, and other private and local funds.

Hilltop Early Learning Center

The Hilltop Early Learning Center provides free prekindergarten to the Hilltop community, including access to Nationwide Children's Hospital, counseling services, and food pantries all under one roof. CDBG funds were used for the design of the facility.

Glenwood Community Pool

The Columbus Recreation and Parks Department leveraged CDBG, CDBG-CV, and additional local funds to transform an outdated and ill-equipped community pool into a safe, modern outdoor aquatics facility that serves as a recreational hub for the Greater Hilltop community.

Sanctuary Night

Sanctuary Night provides services for persons experiencing sexual exploitation by offering trauma-informed and survivor-led care and support. The City has supported their staffing and program needs with CDBG and CDBG-CV funds (both state and local).

Warner Junction

Warner Junction is a 50-unit workforce housing development consisting of 2 and 3-bedroom units in five duplexes, as well as 1 and 2-bedroom units in a mixed-use, multi-family building. The development features a community space, leasing office, fitness room, and healthcare space.

Dodge Park Playground

CDBG funds were used to replace the playground at Dodge Park, which had reached the end of its useful life, to bring the park up-to-date and ensure that the park's features allow for safe, healthy, and quality recreation for all ages.

Harriet's Hope

Harriet's Hope provides permanent supportive housing for women that have experienced chronic homelessness or human trafficking. The community utilizes community partnerships and resources to meet the practical, emotional, mental, spiritual, and financial needs of victims of human trafficking in Central Ohio and to reduce re-victimization.
