

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The City of will hold a public hearing to encourage citizen participation in the City's 2026 U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Annual Action Plan planning process. The Consolidated Plan and associated Annual Action Plans set goals and define priorities for housing and community development investment in Columbus. The Consolidated Plan governs the City's investment of four federal grants: the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), the HOME Investment Partnerships Program (HOME), the Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS Program (HOPWA), and the Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG). These grant funds are intended to primarily support low- to moderate-income residents of Columbus. The Draft 2026 Annual Action Plan (AAP) outlines goals and projects for these four HUD grants.

The City will hold a Public Meeting on June 2, 2026 at 4:00 PM at the 141 N. Front Street conference room to present and discuss the Draft 2026 Annual Action Plan. Parking is available for free in the garage at 141 N. Front Street.
