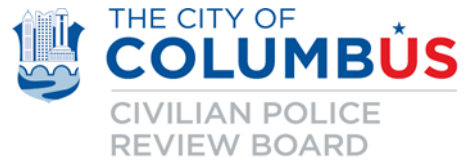

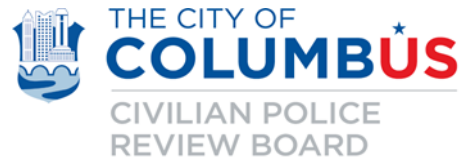

8. The complainants alleged officers placed complainants in cruisers with no A/C or windows put down, even after they asked.

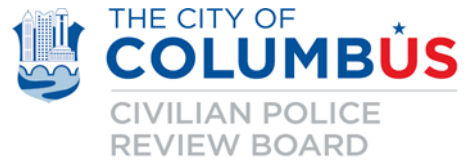
