Incident Summary: *** UPDATE: On August 17, 2025, at 3:44 p.m., the victim, THOMAS SMITH, age 56, was pronounced deceased. An arrest warrant was filed for JOSHUA BAYS, age 45, charging him with Murder. On August 28, 2025, Bays was arrested without incident by Columbus Police SWAT personnel. ***				
On August 14, 2025, at 1:42 p.m., Columbus Police officers responded to the 1200 block of W. Broad St. on a reported shooting. Upon arrival, officers located one adult victim who was unresponsive and had suffered a gunshot wound. Columbus Fire medics responded to the scene and transported the victim to a local hospital. Because of the severity of the injuries, the Homicide Unit will conduct this investigation.				
The victim has been identified and that information is being withheld at this time. Detectives are working to establish a motive for the shooting.
