Incident Summary: ****UPDATE 12/11/2025***: Based on information gained during the investigation of this homicide, a murder warrant was issued for Andre Stromer. On December 10, 2025, Andre Stromer was arrested by Columbus Police SWAT personnel without incident.				
Ellis Caldwell, who had been previously charged as a juvenile in this homicide, was re-arrested by SWAT personnel on December 5, 2025 without incident on a Murder warrant for this homicide.				
On May 21, 2021, at approximately 2:05 p.m., Columbus Police Patrol officers responded to a report of shots fired in a parking lot in the 5000 block of Forest Hills Boulevard. Upon arrival, they found the victim, Keishawn Riley, suffering from apparent gunshot wounds. The victim was transported to a local hospital where, despite all efforts by medical personnel, he was pronounced deceased at 2:37 p.m.
