Incident Summary: ***UPDATED 12/4/2025: After the use of security hardware and digital technology, an eye witness was located. After the witness interview, confirmation of previously known facts were verified, and a suspect was identified. An arrest warrant has been filed for Khaliq Traevon Quentin Hunt, M/B/22, for one count of murder for the death of Hannah Taylor. Motive was confirmed as road rage. Mr. Hunt's whereabouts remain unknown at this time. ***

On November 2, 2025, at 10:15 PM, Columbus Police officers responded to the 800 block of E. Hudson St. on a shots fired call. Upon arrival, officers located a single-vehicle traffic crash at the intersection of E. Hudson St. and Velma Av. The officers found two vehicle occupants, both of whom were injured. The vehicle driver, identified as Hannah Taylor, age 22, was unresponsive and sustained a gunshot wound prior to the crash. Columbus Fire medics responded and pronounced Taylor deceased at 10:22 PM. The other occupant, an adult female, was transported to a local hospital for her injures from the crash. Next of kin notification has been made.

The preliminary investigation revealed a possible road-rage incident as the motive.
